01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. The Petitioner apprehending his arrest in Mancheswar P.S. Case No.239 of 2021 registered for alleged commission of offence punishable under Section 394 read with Section 34 of the I.P.C., has filed this petition for his release on pre-arrest bail.
3. Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned counsel for the State.
4. It appears that the Petitioner had earlier approached this Court in ABLAPL No.11916 of 2021, which was dismissed on merit vide order dated 5th October, 2021.
5. Petitioner wants review the aforesaid order dated 5th October, 2021 by filing this present application on the ground

that the aforesaid order is passed on a wrong premises and contrary to the record.

6. Considering the facts and submission made, this Court is not inclined to entertain the prayer made by the Petitioner.

7. Accordingly, the prayer for pre-arrest bail of the Petitioner stands rejected and the ABLAPL is disposed of being dismissed.
