11. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. This application under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. has been filed by the Petitioner with a prayer to quash the order dated 6th September, 2010 passed by the learned Assistant Sessions Judge-cum-C.J.M., Balasore in S.T. No.15/26 of 1993 with further prayer to direct the trial court to proceed with both the cases i.e., G.R. No.1045 of 1991 (S.T. No.15/26 of 1993) and G.R. No.1053 of 1991 (S.T. No.29/119 of 1997) as counter to each other and accordingly deliver judgment successively one after another in conformity with the judgment passed in Criminal Revision No.17/96-95 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Balasore.
3. No one appears on behalf of the Petitioner when the matter is called. However, learned counsel for the State-Opposite Party is present.
4. The case is of the year 2011.

5. As such, this Court is of the view that the Petitioner is a recalcitrant litigant and does not want to proceed with the matter.

6. Hence, this CRLMC stands dismissed for non-prosecution.

7. Interim order dated 22nd April, 2011 passed by this Court in Misc. Case No.777 of 2011 stands vacated.
