 1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
 2. This is the second journey of the Petitioner in filing this application under section-438 of the Cr.P.C. for his grant of bail in the event of his arrest in connection with Khandagiri P.S. Case No.678 of 2019 corresponding to C.T. Case No.5858 of 2019 on the file of learned S.D.J.M., Bhubaneswar running for alleged commission of offence under Section-387/427/34 of the IPC, for his release on bail in the above mentioned case.
