1. This matter is taken up through Video Conferencing mode.
2. This is an application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed by the Petitioner for bail in connection with Junagarh P.S.Case No.421 of 2021, corresponding to C.T. Case No.413 of 2021, pending in the Court of the learned J.M.F.C.,Junagarh for alleged commission of offences under Sections 452,294,323,307,353,506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. Upon consideration of the submissions made by the respective parties as well as on perusal of the records and on consideration of the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that the petitioner is languishing in jail custody since 08.12.2021 and the fact that no external injury found on the body of the injured and co-accused has been released on bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Dharmagarh, I am inclined to release the Petitioner on bail in the above case, on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty thousand) with one local solvent surety for the like amount to

the satisfaction of the learned court in seisin over the matter subject to condition that the Petitioner shall not indulge in such type of offence while on bail. Further, it is open to the court in seisin over the matter to impose any additional condition (s), if situation so warrants.

4. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.

5. As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID -19 situation are continuing, learned counsel for the parties may utilize a print out of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned Advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587, dated 25th March, 2020, modified by Court's Notice No.4798, dated 15th April, 2021, and Court's Office Order circulated vide Memo Nos.514 and 515 dated 7th January, 2022.
