1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
 2. This the successive journey of this Petitioner in filing this application under section-438 of the Cr.P.C. for his grant of bail in the event of his arrest in connection with Patkura P.S. Case No.66 of 2018 corresponding to G.R. Case No.421 of 2018 on the file of learned S.D.J.M., Kendrapara running for alleged commission of offence under Section-498-A/306/34 of the IPC, for his release on bail in the above mentioned case.
 3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
 4. Considering the submissions and on going through the materials on record as also other surrounding circumstances; while being not inclined to grant of anticipatory bail to the Petitioner, this application is disposed of with the observation that when the occasion would so arise before the learned Court
