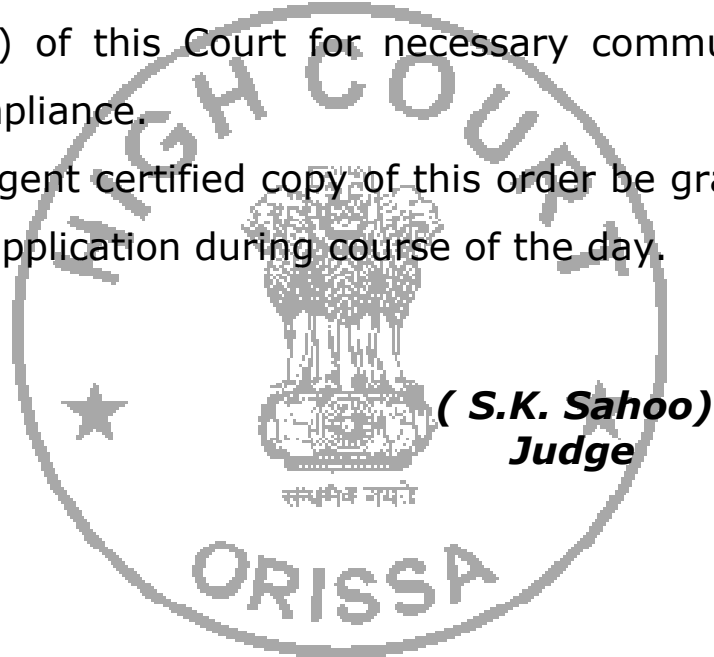
The unconditional apology is accepted.
