1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
  2. The Petitioner being in custody in connection with Nayagarh Sadar P.S. Case No.36 of 2020 corresponding to G.R. Case No.150 of 2020 on the file of learned S.D.J.M., Nayagarh running for commission of offence under sections 341/294/323/325/326/307/506/34 of the IPC, have filed this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for their release on bail.
  3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
  4. Taking into account the submissions made; further keeping in view the materials on records with other surrounding circumstances as also the period of detention of the Petitioners in custody and in the absence of any such impediment; it is directed that the Petitioners be released on bail in the aforesaid case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper by

the court in seisin of the case with further conditions that they will appear in person before the Court in seisin of the Case on each date of posting of the case; will report before the IIC, Nayagarh Sadar P.S. on every Monday in between 10 am to 2 pm for a period of next one year; and will not terrorize or threaten the prosecution witnesses in any manner.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.

As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19 situation are continuing, learned Counsel for the parties may utilize a printout of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned Advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587 dated 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2020 as modified by Court's Notice No.4798 dated 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 and Court's Office order circulated vide Memo Nos.514 and 515 dated 7<sup>th</sup> January, 2022.
