1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

3. The CRLMC has been filed for quashing of G.R. Case No.2123 of 2020, on the file of on the file of learned J.M.F.C.(R), Cuttack, on the ground of compromise between the parties. An affidavit has been filed evidencing of such compromise is kept on record.
4. Taking into account such compromise and in view of the principle laid down by the Apex Court in the case of ***Manoj Agarwal & Another v. The State of Uttar Pradesh & Another*** dated 04.03.2022 in SLP (CRL) No.(s) 8242/2021, the proceeding

in connection with G.R. Case No.2123 of 2020, arising out of Cuttack Sadar P.S. Case No.493 of 2020, on the file of learned J.M.F.C., Cuttack, stands quashed in respect of the present petitioners in exercise of power under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
