3. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. The Appellant in this appeal seeks to assail the order dated 16th November, 2009 passed by learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Aska in Gua.A.P. No.2 of 2005 (Gua.A.P. No.14 of 2005 GDC) rejecting the petition filed by him under Section 25 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890.
