1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
2. It is alleged that in spite of a direction of this Court given in W.P.(C) No.37715 of 2020 thereby targeting the Lease Case no.376/69, the same is yet to be concluded
3. Considering the submissions made by the parties and keeping in view the constrain faced by the public authorities due to the pandemic situation for COVID-19 as well as the Election process being conducted in the State, this Court directs, if the proceeding vide Lease Case No.37715 of 2020 remains undisposed of in spite of a targeting direction of this Court, the same shall be disposed of by the Tahasildar, Bhubaneswar-O.P.2 within a period of four months from the date of communication of an authenticated copy of this order by the Petitioner.
4. The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
