1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
2. It appears, the Petitioner being a senior citizen aged about 87 years old has made a complaint regarding difficulties being created by the local people.
3. Considering the allegation made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner and looking to the age of the Petitioner, this Court directs the Collector, Puri to look into the grievance of the Petitioner vide Annexure-1(series) and take a lawful decision in the matter taking into account the grounds stated in this writ petition so also the documents appended thereto.
4. The entire exercise shall be completed involving the Petitioner and also the persons likely to be affected, within a period of one & half months from the date of communication of an authenticated copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition by the Petitioner.
5. The writ petition stands disposed of.
