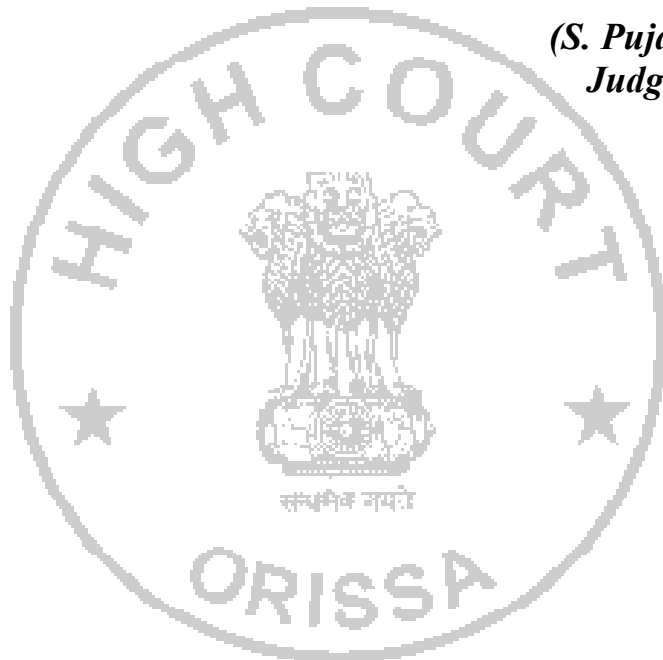

1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.

The petitioner in this application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short “Cr.P.C.”) has prayed for quashing of the order dated 19.07.2010 passed by the learned Special Judge (Vigilance), Berhampur in G.R. Case No.37 of 2004 refusing to discharge her and framing charge under Section 13(2) read with Section 13(1)(e) of the P.C. Act and Section 109 of IPC against her.
