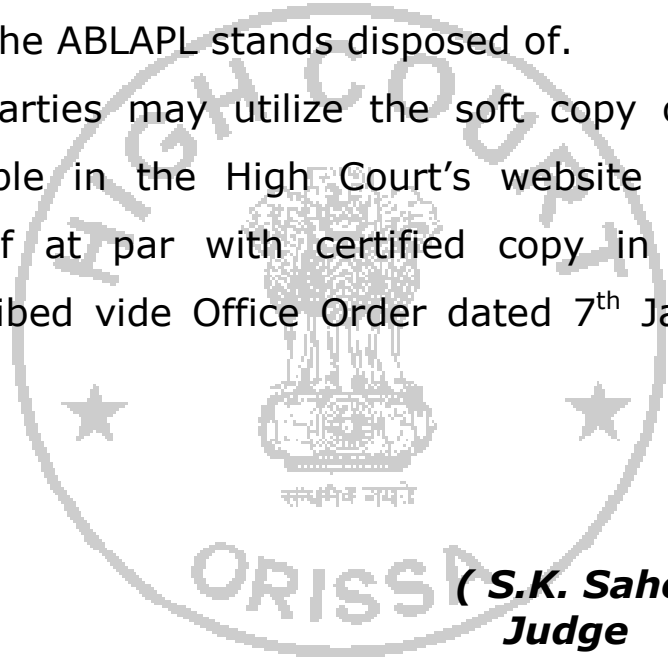
Perused the F.I.R.
