01. 1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
2. Considering the submissions made by the parties and without expressing any opinion on the claim of the Petitioner, this Court directs the Opposite Party No.2 to consider the representation at the instance of the Petitioner vide Annexure-4 and take a lawful decision in the matter taking into account the grounds stated in this writ petition so also the documents appended thereto. It is further directed that if the Petitioner is in possession of the disputed property in question, no coercive action shall be taken against the Petitioner till a decision is taken in the matter.
3. The entire exercise shall be completed involving all the parties concerned within a period of three months from the date of communication of an authenticated copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition by the Petitioner.
4. The writ petition stands disposed of with the above order.

5. As restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19 situation are continuing, learned counsel for the parties may utilize a printout of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587, dated 25th March, 2020 as modified by Court's Notice No.4798, dated 15th April, 2021 and Court's Office order circulated vide memo Nos.514 & 515 dated 7th January, 2022.
