1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioners are in custody since 29.09.2021 and 30.09.2021 respectively in connection with Tirtorl P.S. Case No.420 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No.403 of 2021 pending in the Court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Jagatsinghpur for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 498-A/302/304B/34 of IPC read with Section 4 of D.P. Act.
4. Considering the nature of accusations and existence of materials prima facie to support the same, I am not inclined to allow the prayer for bail, which is therefore, rejected.
5. BLAPL is accordingly rejected.
