This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.

2. Heard Mr. S.K. Padhi, learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. By means of this writ petition, the petitioners seek direction to the opposite parties to settle the government plot in question in their favour.

4. It is contended by Mr. Padhi, learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are in occupation of the plot in question for more than thirty years by constructing their houses over the same and also enjoying electricity connection.

5. This Court is not inclined to entertain the writ petition. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to approach the appropriate forum in accordance with law.

6. With that liberty, the writ petition stands disposed of.
