3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking to quash the letter dated 07.07.2021 under Annexure-4 and letter dated 03.08.2021 under Annexure-5 and he further seeks direction to the opposite parties to release all the financial benefits, which were recovered illegally.

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.3 vide Annexure-6 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
