04. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
2. The petitioners in this application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short “Cr.P.C.”) have prayed for quashing of the order of cognizance dated 11.07.2012 passed by the learned S.D.J.M., Paralakhemundi in G.R. Case No.77 of 2012 taking cognizance of the offences under Sections 498-A, 294, 506/34 of IPC and Section 4 of the D.P. Act.
3. No one appears for the petitioners at the time of call. This case is of the year 2012 and near about one decade has already been passed from the date of filing of this case. As such, the petitioners appear to be recalcitrant litigants and have lost interest in the present litigation. Hence, this CRLMC stands

dismissed for non-prosecution. Interim order dated 08.10.2012 passed by this Court stands vacated.

4. However, liberty is given to the petitioners to raise all such contentions at the time of framing of charge, if charge has not been framed in the meanwhile.
