This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to sanction the scale of pay of Rs.44,900-Rs.1,42,400/- which is the prescribed scale of pay as per recruitment rules for the post of trained graduate teacher in Ekalabya Model Residential School vide Annexure-8 dated 12.02.2020 and pay all service and financial benefits retrospectively within a stipulated time.

3. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.3 vide Annexure-11 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time.

4. Considering the contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing opposite party no.3 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-11, and pass appropriate

order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production/communication of certified/authenticated copy of this order.

As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19 situation are continuing, learned counsel for the parties may utilize a print out of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned advocate, in the manner prescribed, vide Court's Notice No.4587 dated 25th March, 2020, as modified by Court's notice no. 4798 dated 15th April, 2021, and Court's Office Order circulated vide Memo Nos.514 and 515 dated 7th January, 2022.
