 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
 2. None appears for the Petitioner at the time of call.
 3. This RPFAM has been filed assailing the judgment and order dated 24th February, 2011 passed by learned Judge, Family Court, Bhubaneswar in Crl. Petition No.34 of 2011 (arising out of Misc. Case No. 115 of 2010).
