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1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody since 09.11.2021 in connection with Sundargarh Town P.S. Case No.302 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No.1749 of 2021 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Sundargarh for the alleged commission of offence under Section 323/353/307 of IPC read with Section 25 & 27 of Arms Act.
4. It is alleged that the petitioner had committed dacoity in a bank on the point of gun and shortly thereafter a raid was conducted by police, during which, the petitioner attempted to fire from the service revolver of his father, who is a police officer, at the raiding party.
5. Considering the fact that charge sheet has already been submitted and the petitioner has been in custody for nearly 10

months, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail. Let the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the court in seisin over the matter may deem fit and proper to impose including the condition that he shall personally appear before the trial Court on each date of posting of the case without fail. Further he shall personally appear before the IIC of Sundargarh Town P.S. on every Sunday at 10 a.m. till conclusion of trial and such fact shall be certified by the IIC to the concerned court once in every month.

6. BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
