01. 1. This matter is taken up through Video Conferencing mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for both the parties and perused the records.
3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail.
4. Considering the nature and gravity of offences alleged against the Petitioner, I am not inclined to release the Petitioner on bail. However, this Court directs that in the event the Petitioner surrenders before the learned J.M.F.C., Aska, in the G.R. Case, which arises out of Dharakote P.S. Case No.0102 of 2021, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper.
5. It is further directed that in the event of release of the Petitioner, he shall not indulge in any offences, tamper with the evidence or influence any prosecution witness, especially the victim wife.
6. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.

7. As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID -19 situation are continuing, learned counsel for the parties may utilize a print out of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned Advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587, dated 25th March, 2020 as modified by Court's Notice No.4798, dated 15th April, 2021 and Office Order dated 7th January, 2022.
