1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/physical) mode.
 2. The Petitioner having been implicated in connection with Sambalpur Vigilance P.S. Case No.70 of 2019 corresponding to V.G.R. Case No.31 of 2019 on the file of learned Special Judge, (Vigilance), Sundargarh running for alleged commission of offence under 409/420/468/120-B of the IPC read with section- 13(2) and section-13(1)(c) of the P.C. Act has filed this application under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. for his release on bail in the event of his arrest in the above case.
 3. Heard Mr. P.K. Nayak, learned Counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. M.S. Rizvi, learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the Vigilance.
 4. Considering the submissions and on going through the materials as placed; further keeping in view the surrounding

circumstances of the case as also concerning the Petitioner; it is directed that in the event, the Petitioner surrenders before the Court in seisin of the case in connection with the above mentioned case within three weeks hence and moves for his release on bail, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper by the Court in seisin of the case with the further condition that the Petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation as and when required and shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner.

Violation of the condition would entail cancellation of bail.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
