2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to consider the case of the petitioner for his promotion to the post of Junior Clerk retrospectively and to grant the benefit under RACP Scheme as well as the arrear dues towards house rent allowance within a stipulated period.
4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.4 vide Annexure-2 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State counsel has raised no objection.
