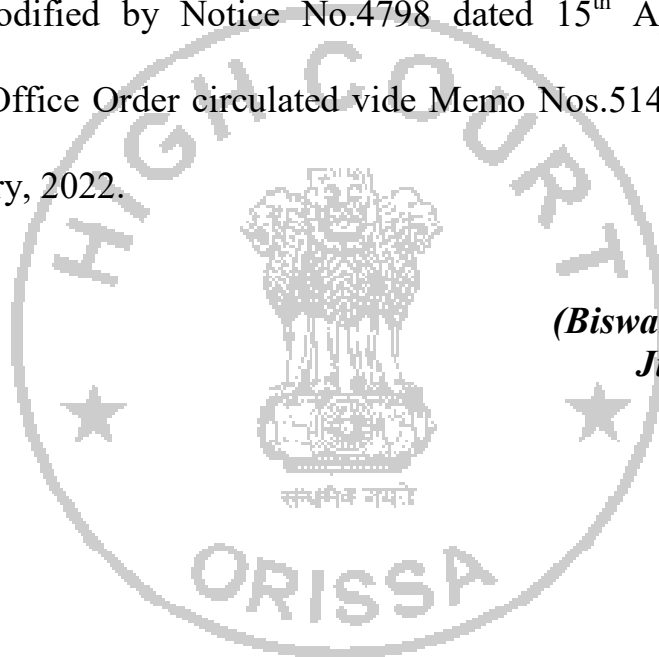

01.      1.      This matter is taken up through video conference mode.
2.      2.      Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
3.      3.      For the nature of dispute involved particularly the allegation involving illegal settlement of a land in favour of the private Opposite Parties, this Court has no jurisdiction to entertain such allegation. In disposal of the Writ Petition as not entertainable even involving the representation at Annexure-3, this Court observes, if the Petitioner has any remedy may avail the same.
4.      4.      It is at this stage of the matter, learned counsel for the Petitioner requests for withdrawal of the Writ Petition.

5. The Writ Petition is thus permitted to be withdrawn.
