The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to promote the petitioner to the rank of Odisha Revenue Service, Group-B (Junior Branch) with effect from 29.12.2021 and to grant all financial and consequential service benefits flowing from the date of promotion.
