This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party no.4 to make payment of the outstanding arrear salary and death benefits of late husband of the petitioner, who has been working as Assistant Teacher at Ostia Project Upper Primary School under Block Education Officer, Banki-I, Banki and died on 20.09.2020 during course of his employment.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.4 vide Annexure-4 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

4. As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, however, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of directing opposite party no.4 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-4, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production/communication of certified copy of this order.
