3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to revise the pay of her husband w.e.f. 09.07.1999 in the promotional post of MPHS (Male) and release all consequential benefit as per order dated 03.12.2018 issued by opposite party no.1.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.3 vide Annexure-10 and the same may be directed to be considered taking into consideration Annexures-6 & 8 within a stipulated time to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
