This matter is taken up by Hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to grant the benefits of financial up-gradation under RACP Scheme to him to Grade Pay of Rs.4,200/-, Rs.4,600/- and Rs.4,800/- with Pay Band-2 on completion of 10, 20 & 30 years of service respectively and he further seeks direction to opposite parties no.2 & 3 to pay all consequential financial benefits to him within a stipulated period.

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner may be permitted to move a fresh representation highlighting his grievances before the authority so that the same can be considered in the light of the ratio decided by this Court in *State of Odisha and another v.*

Bihari Lal and others (W.P.(C) No.2831 of 2016 disposed of on 27.06.2016).

5. Considering the limited nature of grievance of the petitioner, this Court directs the petitioner to file a fresh representation within a period of fifteen days from today ventilating his grievances before the authority. In the event the petitioner files such representation along with the judgment passed by this Court in ***Bihari Lal*** (supra), the authority shall consider and pass appropriate order taking into consideration the ratio decided in ***Bihari Lal*** (supra) within a period of two months thereafter.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the writ petition is disposed of.
