The petitioners have filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to extend the promotional benefits as well as financial benefits in their favour as per office memorandum dated 26.04.2013 under Annexure-1, office memorandum dated 18.01.2016 under Annexure-2, Resolution dated 26.11.2018 under Annexure-5 and letter dated 04.12.2018 under Annexure-6 of the Government of Odisha in Finance Department.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioners have made representation to opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-13 series and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
