1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. This petition has been filed by the Petitioner for transfer of C.P. Case No.379 of 2019 instituted at the instance of Opposite Party-husband from the file of the learned Judge, Family Court, Bhadrak to the Court of Judge, Family Court, Bhubaneswar.
3. Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned counsel for the Opposite Party.
4. It is stated that a divorce case being C.P. No.639 of 2019 filed by the Petitioner is pending before the Court of Judge, Family Court, Bhubaneswar and the other case, i.e., C.P. No.379 of 2019 for restitution of conjugal life has been filed by the Opposite Party-husband before the Court of Judge, Family Court, Bhadrak.

5. The Petitioner seeks transfer of the aforesaid C.P. case to the Court of Judge, Family Court, Bhubaneswar.

6. Learned counsel for the Opposite Party, however, has not objected to transfer the said case.

7. But, considering the facts and submissions made, this Court directs that C.P. Case No.379 of 2019 pending on the file of the learned Judge, Family Court, Bhadrak be transferred to the Court of Judge, Family Court, Bhubaneswar. Both the Courts shall do the needful on production of the certified copy of this order. Learned Judge, Family Court, Bhubaneswar after transfer of the aforesaid C.P. case shall dispose of the same as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of eight months, since it is a matrimonial matter.

8. With the aforesaid order, this transfer petition stands disposed of.

9. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
