3. The petitioner is in custody since 13.11.2021 in connection with P.R. No.230 of 2021-22 corresponding to 2(a)CC No.243 of 2021 of the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Rayagada for the alleged commission of offence under Section 52(a) of Odisha Excise Act.
