This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to disburse the financial assistance under CESCO Rehabilitation Assistance Regulation, 2000 in favour of the petitioner, after death of her husband, by considering her representation under Annexure-5.
4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-5 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time.
