2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite party no.2 to consider the case of the petitioner for re-engagement in the post of Road Roller Driver/ Driver lying vacant in the office of the District Rural Development Agency, Rayagada and regularize his service taking consideration his length of service rendered under the opposite parties.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-4 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State counsel has raised no objection.
