2. Heard Mr. H. B. Sutar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. K.K. Gaya, learned counsel for the Opposite Parties.

Being aggrieved by her non-selection as Anganwadi helper of Binatara Anganwadi Center, the petitioner is stated to have preferred an appeal to the Sub-Collector, Bhadrak, (Opposite Party No.3) which is on record at Annexure-6. On perusal of Annexure-7, it is seen that the said representation was sent to the Sub-Collector, Bhadrak (Opposite Party No.3) by Registered Post.
