This matter is taken up by hybrid mode.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party no.1 to implement the order dated 22.09.1998 under Annexure-2 which has been confirmed by this Court on 07.02.2019 and extend the benefits of arrear salary as well as pension and other retirement to him i.e. 01.06.2002 onwards within a stipulated time.

3. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made representation before opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-4, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time taking into consideration Annexure-2 and 3 within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

4. As agreed by learned counsel for the parties, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of directing opposite party no.1 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner under

Annexure-4 taking into consideration Annexure-2 and 3, and pass a reasoned and speaking order as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
