2. Heard.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party no.1 to enquire into the matter about the non-deposited deducted amount towards E.P.F. to opposite party no.5 for the period from 14.01.2011 to 01.12.2014 for the purpose of E.P.F. Pension Scheme.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made a representation to opposite party No.1 vide Annexure-5 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned counsel for the State has no objection.
