This matter is taken up by hybrid mode.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite parties to antedate the appointment of the petitioner w.e.f. 23.12.2006, and further seeks direction to grant all financial and consequential benefits treating the appointment of the petitioner w.e.f. 23.12.2006, within a stipulated time.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made representation before opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-4, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time taking into consideration Annexure-3 series within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.
