This is an Assessee is appeal against order dated 26th May, 2017 of the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal, Cuttack (ITAT) in ITA No.44/CTK/2017 for the Assessment Year 2009-10, the question sought to be urged by the Assessee for consideration is whether the ITAT was justified in upholding the fixing of the profit rate @ 7% of the turnover, whereas the Assessee was asking it to be fixed at 2 %?
