1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Learned State Counsel has obtained instructions to the effect that the victim is not interested to marry the petitioner.
3. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
4. The petitioner is in custody since 30.01.2022 in connection with Kotagarh P.S. Case No. 10 of 2022 corresponding to C.T. Case No. 14 of 2022 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., Kotagarh for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 376(2)(n)/506 of IPC.
5. Considering the submissions made, the materials on record, the period of detention in custody and in particular the statement of the victim recorded under Section 164 of Cr.P.C. I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail. Let the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the court in seisin over the matter

may deem fit and proper to impose including the condition that the petitioner shall personally appear before the trial court on each date of posting of the case without fail.

6. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
