 3. The Petitioners are in custody since 6th September, 2021 in connection with Turekela P.S. Case No.158/2021 corresponding to S.C. Case No.24/2021 pending in the court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Kantabanji for the alleged commission of the offence under Sections 498-A/302/34 of I.P.C. and Section 4 of the D.P. Act.
