**02.** This matter is taken up by virtual/physical mode.

**1.** The contempt petition arises out of W.P.(C) No. 33201 of 2021, wherein it has been alleged that order dated 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 passed by this Court has not been complied with.

In the writ petition, the Opposite Party No.2 i.e., the Director of Industries, Odisha is directed to re-examine the entire matter and take a fresh decision on the Petitioner's request, not later than 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2022.

**2.** Counsel for the Petitioner concedes that upon passing the order dated 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 by the Director of Industries, Odisha, the directions contained in the order dated 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 passed in W.P.(C) No. 33201 of 2021 stand complied with.

3. Accordingly, the CONTC is dismissed as infructuous.
