pending against petitioner regarding unauthorized possession of the Ammonium Nitrate. Mr. Parhi, learned advocate, Deputy Solicitor General along with Mr. Panda appear on behalf of Union of India.

IIC, Kantabanji P.S., Bolangir, Odisha will dispose of by public auction to holder(s) of licence for use and sale of Ammonium Nitrate, the 320 bags of it lying at petitioner's godown in village-Bandhapali, Tahasil-Kantabanji, District-Bolangir. This is to be done within four weeks of communication.

4. The writ petition is disposed of.
