- 03.** 1. At the outset, Mr. L. Samantaray, learned Additional Government Advocate submits that the order dated 27th September, 2019 passed in W.P.(C) No.22672 of 2018 stands duly complied with as O.E.A, Collector has passed a detailed & speaking *quasi-judicial* order on 22nd November, 2019 rejecting the claim of the petitioners.
