01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard Mr. B.B.Routray, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. S.K.Mishra, learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The Petitioner is in custody since 2nd February, 2022, in connection with Barkot P.S. Case No.50/2022 corresponding to Special G.R.Case No.4/2022 pending in the court of learned Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Deogarh for the alleged

commission of the offence under Sections 20(b)(ii)(B) of the NDPS Act.

4. Considering the submissions made, the materials on record and the fact that the seized contraband is less than commercial quantity being 12 kg. 210 grams of ganja, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail.

5. Let the Petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the court in seisin over the matter in the aforesaid case including the condition that he shall appear before the trial court on each date of posting of the case without fail.

6. The BLAPL is disposed of.
