01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in connection with G.R. Case No.2047 of 2021 arising out of Byree P.S. Case No.232 of 2021 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Chandikhole for alleged commission of offences under sections 419/420/407/379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Perused the F.I.R.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner's implication in the case is based on the confessional statement of co-accused and some of the co-accused persons were taken

into custody and they have been released on bail by this Court and on hearing the learned counsel for the State, who submitted that the petitioner's implication came to fore on the basis of co-accused statement of one Avhinash Kumar Thakur and since the offences are triable by Magistrate, I am inclined to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail and accordingly, this Court directs that in the event of arrest of the petitioner in connection with the aforesaid case, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer with further conditions that he shall make himself available for interrogation by the I.O. as and when required and he shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to the Investigating Officer.

Violation of any of the above conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
