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1. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.

2. This writ petition involves the following prayer:

“In the above premises, it is prayed that this Honourable Court may graciously be pleased to:

1. Admit the Writ Petition, call for the records (if any).
2. Issue necessary writ/writs thereby directing the opposite party to waive-off the road tax levied on the vehicle for the period 01/07/2021 to 31/03.2022 of the petitioner forthwith.

3. Pass any other order which your lordships may deem fit & proper.
