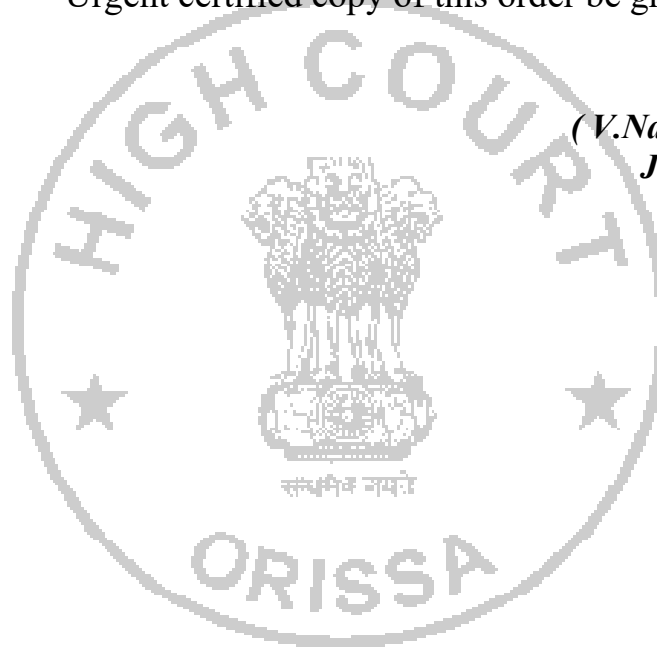

1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard Mr. P.R. Mishra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Mr. U.C. Jena, learned counsel for the petitioner and Miss S. Mishra, learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. Being aggrieved by the order dtd. 05.05.2008 passed in G.R. Case No. 135 of 2004 by the Learned S.D.J.M., Deogarh issuing order of NBWA, the petitioner has approached this Court. While prima facie, this Court does not find any infirmity in the order passed but in order to allow the petitioner to effectively defend himself, it is directed that, in the event, the petitioner surrender within a period of three weeks hence, he shall be released on bail on earlier terms.

4. It is made clear that, in the event the petitioner does not surrender within the time fixed, it shall be open to the prosecution to take effective steps in terms of the impugned order.
5. While being released on bail, it is directed that the petitioner shall furnish his mobile number and email I.D., if any.
6. The CRLMC is accordingly disposed of.
