Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

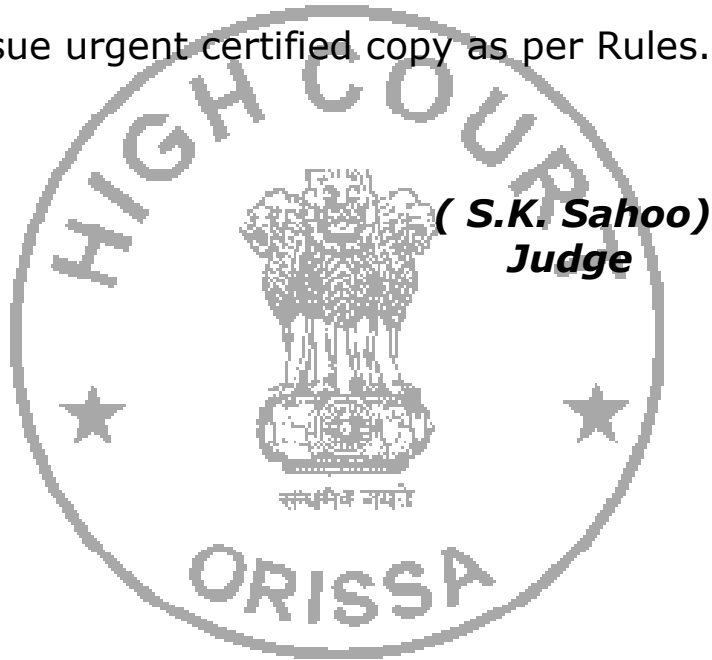
This is an application under section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in connection with Jeypore Mahila P.S. Case No. 17 of 2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No. 166 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Jeypore for the commission of the alleged offences punishable under sections 376(2)(n), 417, 313 and 323 of the Indian Penal Code.

Perused the first information report annexed to the anticipatory bail application.

In view of the nature and gravity of accusation, while not inclining to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, it is observed that in the event the petitioner surrenders and moves for bail in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be disposed of by the learned Courts below in accordance with law expeditiously. The case records shall be made available to the Courts concerned for disposal of the bail application.
