2. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. The matter was not in today's cause list. On being mentioned by Mr. Swain, learned counsel for the Petitioner stating that similar matter at Item No.2 of the supplementary list which is disposed of by a separate order, the same is taken up by a special list on being moved.
3. Perused the note of Deputy Registrar (Judicial).
4. The Petitioners in this writ petition pray for a direction to the Additional Commissioner, Settlement and Consolidation, Berhampur for early disposal of SRP No. 600 of 2019.
5. Mr. Swain, learned counsel for the Petitioners submits that the matter has not yet been considered and notice has not been issued to the opposite parties therein. He, therefore, submits that a direction may be issued to the Additional Commissioner, Settlement and Consolidation, Berhampur to take up the matter for issuance of notice to the opposite parties.

6. Mr. Mishra, learned Additional Government Advocate for the State, on the other hand, submits that he has no instruction as to the status of the case before the said authority and pendency of the matters of similar nature before that court. Hence, he prays for some time to take instruction in the matter.

7. Taking into consideration the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and in view of the order proposed to be passed, this Court feels it proper to proceed with the matter without waiting for the response from the Opposite Parties.

8. In that view of the matter, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction that in the event the Petitioners file a memorandum for consideration of the aforesaid SRP No.600 of 2019 for issuance of notice to the opposite parties along with certified copy of this order before the Additional Commissioner, Settlement and Consolidation, Berhampur -Opposite Party No.2, he shall do well to accept the same and fix a date, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of filing such memorandum for consideration of the matter for issuance of notice to the opposite parties therein, if the matter is otherwise ready and there is no legal impediment.

9. A copy of this order shall be served on Mr. Mishra, learned Additional Government Advocate for information and communication.
